Key Responsibilities:

Content Creation:

Develop engaging and shareable content across various social media platforms (e.g., Facebook, Instagram,) that aligns with our mission and resonates with the dachshund community.

Create visually appealing graphics, videos, and other multimedia content to enhance storytelling and convey information effectively.

Social Media Management:

Implement and manage the social media content calendar, ensuring consistent and timely posting. Monitor social media channels, responding to comments, messages, and mentions in a timely and professional manner.

Stay informed about trends and best practices in social media to enhance our online presence.

Community Engagement:

Foster and strengthen relationships with our online community, including dachshund owners, supporters, and potential partners.

Campaign Coordination:

Coordinate and execute social media campaigns, contests, and promotions to drive engagement and participation.
